The Course

Situated in North Nowra, the golf course nestles between the Shoalhaven River and the escarpment. Some of the tees have even been cut into the escarpment providing unique tees high above the fairways with beautiful river views.

The course is a 5,166-metre par-68 test for men, with two par-3s on the front nine and three par-3s and one par-5 on the back nine. Women play an equally thrilling par-71 layout measuring 5,050 metres.

Although shorter than many modern 18-hole monsters, Nowra Golf Course is none the poorer for it. Trading distance for tight driving lines makes for challenging golf. As does the pinpoint accuracy needed on the approach to relatively small greens.

So don't expect to drive off every tee. Instead, expect to be challenged in your choice of clubs and your course management skills!

There are several signature holes on the course, but arguably its most memorable feature – apart from the riverside setting – is the collection of

- excellent par-3s. Nearest the pin competitions are never dull at Nowra!
- Nowra Golf Course is popular with golfers and is a haven for nature. Visitors may get lucky, and see some local residents like echidnas, lizards and wombats. There is also a wide variety of birdlife and Lyrebirds can often be heard on the course. With its riverside setting and stunning views every experience at Nowra is memorable.





Course Tour

We hope you enjoy your time with us at Nowra Golf Club. Here are a few useful tips and course notes which should help you make the most of your round. Distances shown are from the men's Blue Tees.

Hole 1, 330 metres, par 4

A straight away par 4 down a generous, tree-lined fairway beckons a big drive, but caution is advised with danger lurking in the form of a hazard at approximately 200 metres across the fairway. The approach shot is to a slightly raised, two-tiered green with fall away at the rear and right to a hazard if the shot is too big.

Hole 2, 303 metres, par 4

A severe dog-legged par 4 with that same hazard seen on the opening hole at approximately 160 metres. By clearing the drain, you have a straightin approach to a slightly sloped back-to-front, elongated green which is guarded left and rear by bunkers.

Hole 3, 295 metres, par 4

A rather sharp climb to an elevated tee which intimidates the player to some degree with the need for an accurate drive for a good position to make an approach to quite a small green, bunkered on the left and slightly elevated. A four is always rewarding.

Hole 4, 141 metres, par 3

This can be a scary experience for the novice. Not a long par 3, but intimidating because the prevailing winds when against you can cause even the best hit shot to flirt with the out-of-bounds all the way down the left side. A fairly narrow green makes a small target and a bunker on the right can catch out the overcautious. Expect long putts with subtle breaks.

Hole 5, 337 metres, par 4

A straight away par 4, where the desire is to open the shoulders and a big drive makes for a relatively easy, but accurate approach to an extremely elevated, wide, shallow green with subtle breaks to the river. Most golfers hope for a good up and down from the severe front slope.

Hole 6, 361 metres, par 4

Around the corner from the 5th is this picturesque par 4 (rated 2 on the card) with magnificent views of the Shoalhaven River that is the out-of-bounds all the way down the right-hand side. With a good drive, the approach requires accuracy to avoid running through a green which is slightly elevated and has some subtle breaks.

Hole 7, 302 metres, par 4

Though not long, this hole fools a lot of players. It requires a good drive down the middle avoiding the run-off to the right and the extended tree line on the left. With the correct club selected and the right-hand bunker avoided, a birdie is not out of the equation.

Hole 8, 101 metres, par 3

A unique par 3 experience, but has some bite if missed. A simple approach-type shot of 101 metres from an elevated tee to an elevated green. This hole produces many 'Aces'.

Hole 9, 331 metres, par 4

Many photos are taken of this hole because of the view back to the river and clubhouse and it is mostly used for the long drive hole because of the elevated tee set back into the cliff face. A big straight drive is rewarded with a solid mid to short iron into a narrow green which can spin a short ball back down to the front requiring an 'up and down' for par. Your putting nerves are tested here.

Hole 10, 307 metres, par 4

A fairly straight par 4 that requires a considered approach. A water hole on the left can catch the wayward shot. All the trouble is at the front with a bunker on the right side of a quite long green. Subtle breaks are the order of the day on this green.

Hole 11, 310 metres, par 4

A short climb up to the tee of this par 4 and accuracy is needed here with a gentle fade to set up a challenging approach over a very large bunker on the left, sometimes leaving a very long first putt with a lot of break to make par.

Hole 12, 170 metres, par 3

A straight shot with a mid to long iron will get you to this par 3 with a very narrow target and bunkers on both sides. A lot of bogeys are scored here.

Hole 13, 289 metres, par 4

One of our shorter par fours, but there are trees both sides to catch the wandering ball and the dreaded 'bear pit' to get over. If you have missed all that and the two bunkers, a well positioned first putt below the hole should secure an easy par.

Hole 14, 495 metres, par 5

This par-5 has brought a lot of good players undone. The drive must make the fairway to get a chance at a well-positioned second into the corner, preferably to the right side of the fairway. Then an accurate approach is needed to a very small green with lots of subtle breaks. Easy!

Hole 15, 408 metres, par 4

Every great golf course has a Road Hole, and this is Nowra's. The Willie Nelson hit On The Road Again gets mentioned a lot here on this index 1. With a straight long drive to avoid the 'OB' on the right, the green is reachable in two but most have to take three goes at getting there. Bunkers guard the green on both sides and a hazard awaits on the left. A flat green rewards accurate putting.

Hole 16, 153 metres, par 3

The prettiest hole anywhere. This par 3 presents the player with a wonderful challenge as all the trouble is at the front with a bunker on either side to negotiate and then a right-to-left putt with a lot of swing to have a chance at par.

Hole 17, 202 metres, par 3

This long par 3, with a large bunker covering most of the approach, forces the player to attempt a big hit over the top and inevitably some players go long. Once on the green, a long putt is subject to a lot of break depending on position. Bogeys are not uncommon.

Hole 18, 331 metres, par 4

A hole that has ruined a lot of rounds. It has a severe dogleg left and the turn causes the straight hitter of the ball to cop the penalty of the trees with 150 metres still to go. An approach from anywhere in the corner has to negotiate the bunker guarding the left side of the green and then the ball tends to slide off to the right; not easy. The wise player putts uphill on this green.

Playing Social Member: Social golf only. Lower membership price and lower rate for social green fees, but no administration of handicap and not entitled to play in club competitions.

Junior: Aged 10-17

Remote: Playing rights; lives more than 100km from the club.

Social Member: No golf playing rights, use of the clubhouse facilities only.

Additionally, members in the golfing categories can pay an annual lump sum to eliminate the social green fee payment for 12 months.

Members' Golf

If you like competitive golf, Nowra Golf Club is a great choice of club. The club can offer pennant play for men and women, together with a host of Honour Board competitions and more relaxed social golfing events.

There is no competition more important to clubs in this part of the world than the annual pennants, where clubs play a series of matches against their neighbours through the golfing season for the right to win that season's pennant or flag.

Nowra's men enter a team in the Golf Illawarra B Pennant competition for players with GA handicaps from 5.5 and the Shoalhaven Shield, a pennant competition played between all the Shoalhaven clubs which is open to all handicaps.

The men also play in the White Horse Cup, a competition for clubs throughout the Illawarra and highlands. The region's longest running interclub matchplay competition, it can be enjoyed by players of all abilities, with a maximum permitted handicap of 24.

The club's women are equally passionate about interclub golf, fielding two teams in the Women's Golf Illawarra pennant competition (Gold and Silver divisions).

As well as the regular weekly competitions at Nowra there are a host of Honour Board competitions to be fought for – the club's "majors" – each carrying an accompanying trophy.

Victory in the most prestigious Honour Board events at local club level also entitles the winners to represent their club against their peers in other Golf Illawarra competitions such as the Champion of Champions.

Other club competitions act as local qualifiers with the winner going on to represent Nowra Golf Club in a regional event against other clubs. One of the most notable of these is the Volkswagen Scramble, a hugely popular Pro-Amateur team event run by the PGA of Australia.

Within the club, the main competition day is Saturday for men and women. Ladies also enjoy a competition on Thursdays and the men on Wednesdays. A large group of veterans play on Tuesdays, a social group of golfers called the NAGAS play a 12-hole competition on Mondays, commencing at midday and there is also a social group that plays on Fridays.

With other welcoming groups also enjoying regular play together potential new members should have no worries about finding new playing partners.

With mixed golf, twilight golf during daylight savings and special events to mark key dates in the calendar, there are plenty of opportunities for golfers who enjoy the social side of playing golf more than the competitive element. There is no rule, however, to say that you can't enjoy both!

The Twilight competition always proves very popular and it's worth noting that Social Members

can enter too: you don't need to be a Full Playing Member.

A notable feature at Nowra is how generously members give of their time to promote and improve the club they love, a tradition that dates back to the club's very early days.

There are frequent working bees which add those extra finishing touches to the hard work of the club's greenkeeping staff in keeping the course looking at its picturesque best.
